Chapter 1: Introduction to Giving

Chapter 3 Fun Song Paying Your Tithe

Summary: Song was preformed by the team singers. This song is all about giving God what belongs to him.

Activity: Learn this song and see if you can come up with moves of your own.



Chapter 3: Memory Verse with JV

Summary: JV shares 2 Corinthians 9:7, reminding kids that God loves a cheerful giver and that giving should come from the heart.

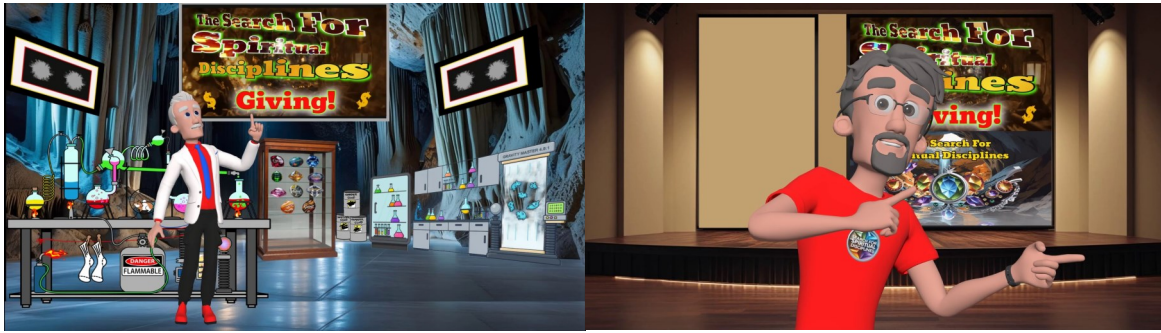
Activity: Memorize the verse and decorate it on a poster to hang in your room.



Chapter 4: Object Lesson: Running Over

Summary: Bill uses objects to show how generous giving leads to overflowing blessings, just like Luke 6:38 teaches.

Activity: Use measuring cups and small objects (beans, coins) to act out “pressed down, shaken together, and running over.”



Chapter 5: Lesson with Professor Whoopie & PF

Summary: Professor Whoopie and PF explain that giving helps grow the Church and shape our character. Giving includes time, talents, and tithes.

Activity: Write or draw a plan for how you can give your time or talents at church or home.



Chapter 6: Comic Adventure: The Dragon's Lair

Summary: The explorers face a dragon while searching for the giving gem, learning that giving requires courage, trust, and teamwork.

Activity: Create your own comic strip showing a team working together to give and help others.



Chapter 7: Wrap-Up with Ollie

Summary: Ollie explains how giving looks in real life—prioritizing God, giving cheerfully, and offering your first and best.

Activity: Make a “Giving Plan” chart with three columns: Time, Talents, and Money. Fill in one way to give in each.
