1. Introduction: Why We Need Guidance

Laura introduces the importance of spiritual guidance for believers. She explains that prayer, Bible study, and listening to wise leaders help us follow God’s path.

Activity: Draw a path with twists and turns. Add signs along the way that say things like “Pray,” “Read the Bible,” and “Ask for Help.”



2. The Big Idea: The Guidance Spiritual Gem

Clyde and Danny talk about how guidance means listening to God’s direction. Danny learns that ignoring advice can lead to trouble, and Clyde explains how God’s guidance keeps us safe.

Activity: Write or act out a short skit where someone ignores advice and gets lost, then finds their way by listening to God.



3. Fun Song—Mission Possible

The Littles and the Quad Band remixed this song for OJO Productions. Find out what this song is saying. See if you can learn it.

Activity: See if there is any other verse or verses you could add that would make this song better. Then sing it to someone in your family.



4. Memory Verse with JV the Bible Junkie

JV shares Isaiah 30:21 and explains how God speaks to us and shows us the right way. He emphasizes that knowing God's voice leads to obedience and peace.

Activity: Make a scroll with the memory verse. Decorate it with arrows pointing in different directions and a big "Walk This Way!" sign.

Object Lesson: Guided by the Holy Spirit

Bill uses a boat in water to show how we drift without guidance. When the Holy Spirit leads us, we move straight toward God's plan.

Activity: Float a paper boat in a bowl of water. Use a straw to gently guide it across. Talk about how God helps steer our lives.



Professor Whoopie & PF Teach Guidance

PW and PF explain that guidance is both personal and shared. They highlight verses from Proverbs, Psalms, Isaiah, and James, showing how God leads us through Scripture, prayer, and community.

Activity: Create a “Guidance Journal” page. Write one thing you’ll ask God for help with this week and one Bible verse to guide you.



Comic Adventure: Finding the Guidance Gem

The explorers journey into Kenya’s Kitum cave, facing danger and learning the importance of following instructions. Danny and Leo retrieve the gem, but Leo is bitten by a bat and miraculously recovers—showing God’s protection and guidance.

Activity: Design your own “Explorer’s Safety Guide.” Include rules like “Listen to God’s voice,” “Follow instructions,” and “Stay with your team.”



Ollie's Wrap-Up: Let God Guide You

Ollie reflects on Leo's recovery and the power of God's guidance. He reminds kids that God's way is always the right way and leads to peace and confidence.

Activity: Write a prayer asking God to guide your steps. Decorate it with stars and arrows pointing upward.
