Summary: JV shares Philippians 4:8, encouraging kids to focus their thoughts on what is true, lovely, and praiseworthy.

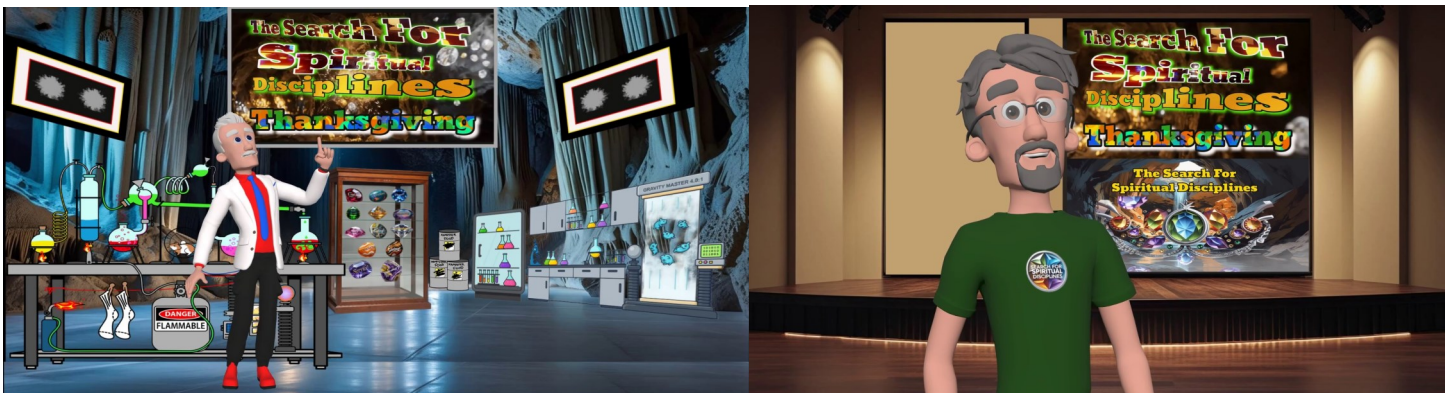
Activity: Memorize Philippians 4:8 and decorate it on a poster with drawings of things that make you feel thankful.

Summary: Bill uses a donut to show how we can focus on what we have instead of what we lack, practicing gratitude.

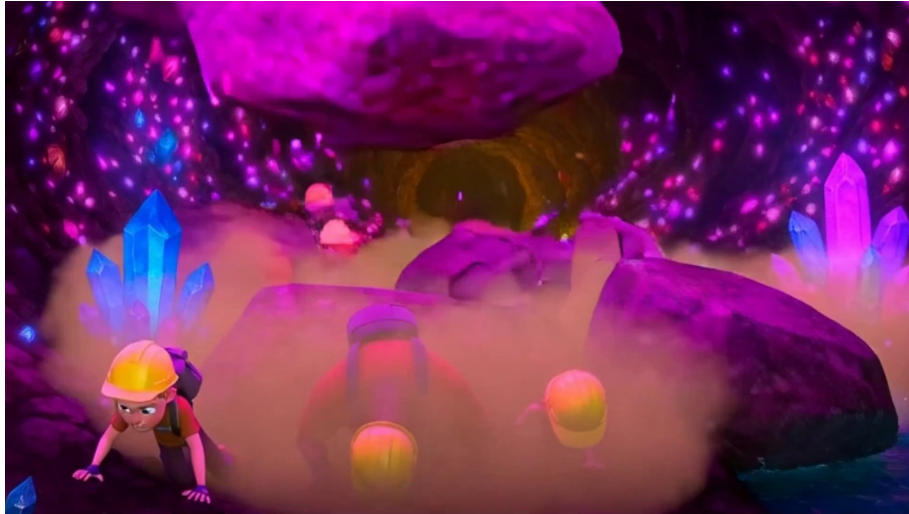
Activity: Draw a donut and write blessings around the outside. In the hole, write things you sometimes wish for but don't need.

Activity: Create a comic strip showing a character giving thanks in a tough situation and being helped because of it.

Summary: Ollie reminds kids that thanksgiving is powerful—even in hard times. Praising God can change our hearts and situations.

Activity: Make a “Praise Poster” with words and drawings that show how you can thank God every day.
