1. Introduction: What Is True Worship?

Laura introduces the concept of worship as honoring God above all else. She explains how idols can distract us from true worship and reminds us of the first commandment. To love God and have no other gods before Him.

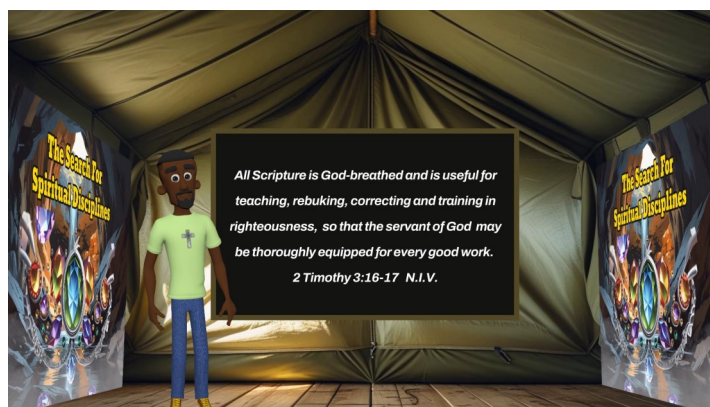
Activity: Draw a picture of something you love (like a toy or hobby). Then write one way you can make sure it doesn't become more important than God.



2. The Big Idea: The Worship Spiritual Gem

Clyde and Danny discuss how worship is not about location but about the heart. They prepare for an adventure to find the Worship Gem, learning that anything can become an idol if not kept in check.

Activity: Create your own "Worship Gem Adventure Map." Mark places where you can worship God (home, church, outdoors, etc.).



3. Memory Verse with JV the Bible Junkie

JV shares 2 Timothy 3:16–17 and explains how the Bible equips us to live rightly. He gives a brief history of how the Bible was written.

Activity: Make a mini scroll with the memory verse. Decorate it and hang it somewhere you'll see it every day.



4. Object Lesson: The Bible Is God's Word

Bill teaches that the Bible is like a flashlight in the dark. It helps guide us when life feels confusing or overwhelming.

Activity: Using a flashlight, explore a dark room and talk about how God's Word helps us see clearly in life.



5. Professor Whoopie & PF Teach Worship

PW and PF explain worship as a full-life response to God's greatness. They highlight examples from Scripture—Abraham, Jesus, Anna—and emphasize worship in spirit and truth.

Activity: Act out one Bible story that shows worship (like Abraham and Isaac or Anna in the temple). Then discuss what worship looked like in that story.



6. Fun Song I've Been Redeemed By the Littles & The Quad Band

Sing the song with the band and have as many of your family sing it with you.

Activity: See if you can come up with at least 3 new verses for the song. Write them in the space below



6. Comic Adventure: Finding the Worship Gem

The explorers climb Haven Mountain and discover a breathtaking cave filled with gems. They learn that worship is powerful, transforming hearts and connecting us to God.

Activity: Design your own Worship Gem! What color is it? What does it represent? Write a short story about how you found it.



Ollie's Wrap-Up: The Right Attitude of Worship

Ollie reflects on the adventure and reminds kids that worship is about being sincere and humble before God. He emphasizes the greatness of God and the beauty of His creation.

Activity: Go outside and look at the sky. Write or draw something that makes you want to worship God.
